7. Treasurer's Report

Cindy Ireland gave a summary of the financial situation: £13,722.73 in the Savings Account £13,483.13 in the Current Account, which includes the Midlands North contribution

8. Competition Secretary's Report

Dawn reported that there were 20 players for County Championships, with 10 players signed up for the Butlin and Julia Sales

31 players signed up for the Senior Womens Championships at Thonock.

The Betterball South had been cancelled due to numbers There were 52 entries for the Betterball Central And 52 entries for the Betterball North

There were only 9 entries for the Autumn Meeting, and 28 players for the County Am Am.

A discussion took place as to why the numbers were down, and it was thought that ladies are still reluctant to play and travel due to Covid.

Dawn confirmed that there were now 638 members signed up on Golf Genius.

A poster will be prepared to send out to all clubs reminding them of the forthcoming County Competitions, Helen Long will send out a poster for the South and Sheilah will send out a poster for the Autumn Meeting.

Dawn confirmed that she would be standing down as Competition Secretary at the AGM, and was pleased to announce that Helen Long had kindly agreed to head a team of 2 other ladies to share the responsibilities, this would mean that if everything is shared then the organiser could actually play in the

competition. Both Helen Long and Helen Grinham were happy to work as a team in this way, and confirmed that they will both remain on the Committee. We agreed to advertise if anyone wants to be part of the team working for a 3 year period. Dawn and Helen will liaise on the wording of a job description.

The Committee thanked Dawn for all her hard work on setting up all the Competitions on Golf Genius, especially County Championships.

8. Junior Co-Ordinator's Report

Stacey confirmed that Polly, Barbara and Kathryn were helping out on the 2nd August for the Girls Golf Day at Elsham G.C. Stacey also asked for any prizes to be donated for the day.

Stacey asked for help on the 25th October for the Golf Sixes and Cindy and Sheilah volunteered.

For the Midlands Festival, Sheilah and Barbara had offered to help out on the 16th August.

Stacey reminded everyone about Lady Presidents Day, which is being held at Lincoln G.C. on the 25th September.

The Patrons event on the 30th September is being held at Cleethorpes G.C. and Kathryn volunteered to help out.

9. Midlands North Report

Angela asked for LWGA comments on the forthcoming meeting with England Golf regarding the upgrade of the National Golf Centre, the Committee agreed with the recommendations put forward by EG and Angela will take this forward.

Angela commented that the Girls Championships on 7th August, at present there were only 11 players, with a poor response from other counties. It was felt that more players could come forward nearer the time.

10. Handicap Advisor's Report

Terry was unable to attend the meeting, and had nothing new to report.

11. League Secretary's Report

Polly reported that results were now coming in thick and fast, but some results sheets were not fully completed and this was taking time to ratify. She urged all Team Captains to complete the results sheets fully with all the information, and to send them in as soon after the match was played.

Polly confirmed that Belton Park had withdrawn from the Scratch League.

The Finals are to be played on 9th September and suggestions were put forward for playing the final with 3 teams. This will be discussed further, and all teams involved will be informed.

13. Any Other Business
