GDPR/Photographs – As part of organising and running this event your name, club, membership number, handicap index and contact details are held on a database by County Officials. These details will not be used in any way other than the administration of the competition. As part of this your name, scores and event photographs will be made available to England Golf, HowdidIdo, County websites and your Home club for the purpose of administration of handicaps and event reporting. Please ensure you enter a current email address as all communication and start times will be sent via email.

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CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

1. Qualifications

Open to female golfers who must be; under 18 years old on 1 January 2024, are members of a County Association within the Midlands North Region, have Amateur Status in accordance with the current R&A Rules Limited and who hold a World Handicap Index.

2. Regulations

- a) Online entries with the appropriate Entry Fee, must be made by the closing date.
- b) Competitors should register at the Registration Desk no later than 30 minutes before their first tee-off time.
- c) Parental Consent Forms must be provided prior to play.
- d) In the event of inclement weather, the Organiser reserves the right to decide over how many holes the competition is played and how the prizes are awarded
- e) Money will not be refunded after the draw has been made.

3. Format & Conditions for Individual and Team Competitions

- a) The individual competition shall consist of 36 holes stroke play (Championship) and 18 hole stroke play (Challenge).
- b) Handicap Index Limit at date of entry not more than 16.5(for the Championship) and 16.6 - 32.7 (for the Challenge)
- c) If a player's handicap index drops below 16.5 between entering the Challenge and the competition day, the player should transfer to the Championship and play 36 holes. If a player decides not to transfer and is playing off 16.5 or less, she will NOT be eligible for the Challenge Trophy but may win a prize
- d) The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A of St Andrews, Local Rules of the Club and Standard Conditions of Competition (Hard Card)
- e) A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. Mobile phones as DMD's are not permitted.
- f) Players shall walk at all times unless permitted to ride by the organising committee on production of a current medical certificate. (Refer to Golf England Transportation Policy)
- g) Caddies are allowed in the 36 hole Championship and must be Under 18. Caddies are not allowed in the 18 hole Challenge.

Team Competition

A team challenge will be run in conjunction with the Championship.

County Junior Organisers are responsible for entering teams made up of 3 players who have entered the 36 hole Championship.

Information on the details for entering teams will be emailed to County Junior Organisers allowing time for CJOs to organise a team or teams once individual entries for the Championship have closed.

The best two gross 36 hole scores for each team will form the overall team score.

There is no limit to the number of teams a county may enter.

4. Trophies & Prizes

- a) Winner of the best 36 hole gross score will be the MNR Girls Champion.
- b) Trophies will be awarded for the best gross and nett scores in both the Championship and Challenge competitions.
- c) Team trophy will be awarded to the winning scratch team.
- d) Prizes will be awarded for best gross and nett scores in both the Championship and Challenge Competition, together with team prizes. No competitor may take more than one individual prize, but will be eligible for a team prize.
- e). All ties shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3, or 1 holes.
