Golf Sixes

The Golf Sixes series of competitions, a new initiative from the Golf Foundation, has arrived in Lincolnshire. It is designed to encourage novice golfers to stay in the game by increasing their opportunities to play on the course.

The Golf clubs who expressed an interest in being involved in this year's Golf Sixes series were asked to field teams of 6 children with very high handicaps - or no handicaps at all. The children play 6 holes of golf over a shortened course, in pairs scramble format. The format is fun and friendly and team scores are converted to points which will accumulate over the full series of 6 matches, with a presentation of medals for the overall winners.

Lincolnshire has 2 divisions, north and south and the north division clubs are Lincoln, Ashby Decoy, Holme Hall, Gainsborough and Elsham golf clubs.

The Junior Section of Lincoln GC was pleased to welcome 30 Academy level juniors from the 5 clubs in the North Lincolnshire area to play in the first of this new Golf Sixes League on Thursday 12th April. We played the pairs scramble over our first 6 holes and everyone enjoyed themselves, although the weather was really unkind - feeling bitterly cold in the damp and the wind.

Each team had special team shirts of a different colour and on a sunny day it will be nice to see them out on the course! However the children braved the weather long enough for a team photo - see below.
